SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2 ENTRIES

Competitors may enter the series by notifying the Rear Commodore or the Race Committee by mail, email or verbally at any time prior to the start of the first race.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to competitors will be posted on the CRSA web page and handed out at the skippers' meetings prior to each race.

4 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed from the flagpole located at the Mary-Margaret while docked in the Cave Run Marina. No postponements will be signaled ashore.

5 SCHEDULE

The first Beginners Regatta will be held May 21st. The second Beginners Regatta will be held May 28th. The third Beginners Regatta will be held August 20th. Skippers meeting will be held at 10AM at the Scott Creek Boat Ramp. The first race will begin as soon as practical. Subsequent races will be held immediately following the completion of each race.

6 CLASS FLAGS

Only one start will be given and the class flag for that start will be the Blue flag.

7 RACING AREA

The racing area will be in the main pool of Cave Run Lake.

8 COURSES and MARKS

The course will be a windward-leeward course one time around. See diagram below.

9 STARTING AND FINISHING LINES

The starting and finishing lines will be between the pole on the Race Committee Boat flying the orange flag (starboard end) and a mark placed by the race committee.

10 TIME LIMIT

The time limit for each race will be thirty minutes for the first boat to finish. Boats finishing more than 30 minutes after the first boat that sails the course finishes will be scored DNF. This changes RRS 35.

11 PROTESTS

Protests shall be delivered to the race committee within 30 min after the race committee finish boat docks. The protest time limit and a list of protests received will be posted on the Mary Margaret and at the club social following the race. Hearings will be held as soon as possible after racing each day at the Mary-Margaret.

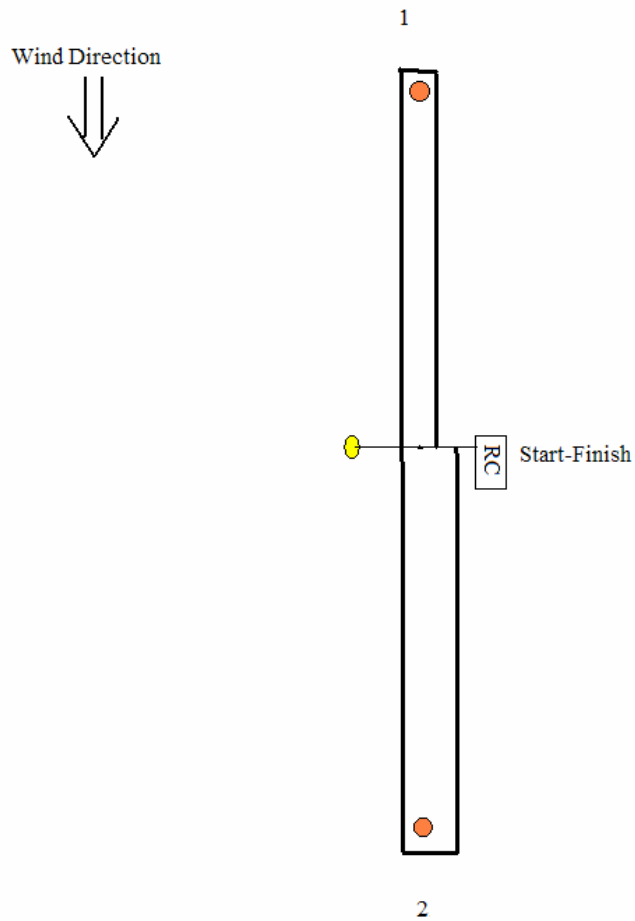
12 SCORING

The Low Point System of Appendix A of the racing rules will apply with modifications. A minimum of one race shall constitute a series. All races will be scored

13 Awards

Awards will be made to first, second and third place for each class at a time and place to be announced by the race committee.

Windward - Leeward



All boats start between starting mark and RC boat. Then proceed to 1 (upwind) then to 2 (downwind) then finish between mark and RC (upwind).
