Club Sunfish Operation Checklist

Please read and understand this list before using a club Sunfish.

In order to successfully transport and utilize a club sunfish, you must have the following:

- 17/8 ball for towing the Sunfish trailer
- Tiller and its extension
- Centerboard
- Mast
- Boom (spars)
- Halyard and mainsheet
- Sail
- Bow line

The Sunfish are kept outside under cover of a tarp. The rest of the equipment can be found inside the conex. The mast, boom, halyard, mainsheet and sail should be rolled up together for efficient storage and transportation.

When you are finished with the Sunfish you will need to re-cover it with the tarp to help keep the boat in good condition. Transporting and storing the mast, boom, halyard and mainsheet in the above described manner ensures safe travel and efficient storage as well as longevity of the equipment so the Sunfish can be enjoyed by all for years to come. *Remember to lock the conex after you have stored all of the equipment*. Remember, we are a volunteer organization working with limited funds and part of maintaining equipment comes by way of responsible use of the club's equipment.
