### Captains Needed for Beginning Sailing Water Lab May 8<sup>th</sup>.

This is another reminder that captains are needed for the Beginning Sailing Water Lab. Please come to the Marina about 8:45 am on May 8<sup>th</sup>. Bring food and drinks for yourself for lunch. Captains will take students out for a sail and have the students learn to motor away from the dock, raise the sails, tack, jibe and review the rules of road. It is especially important to review how to trim the sails and handle gusts. Students should have as much "tiller time" as possible. Before leaving the dock please give each student a quick tour of your boat and explain why you like it. We may meet for lunch at the Marina, change students and go out again. Plan to return to the dock about 3:45 pm.

## **Details on the 2021 Beginning Sailing Classes**

Venues: May 4 and 6, 2021, 6:30-8:30 PM

Location will be in Lexington and will be finalized by the end of the month. Registrants will be notified.

May 8, 2021, 8:45 AM-4:00 PM Cave Run Lake, Morehead KY

The Beginning Sailing course is a good way to determine if you like sailing and wish to continue learning how to sail. Students with no sailing experience who wish to have an introduction to sailing, or those with limited or time warn experience can take this course as a refresher rather than starting with ASA 101, which is also offered by CRSA. The Beginning Sailing course is economical, provides classroom and on the water learning experiences, and an introductory textbook for \$35 per person. Membership in CRSA (\$100/family) is required for insurance purposes.

ASA courses which can be taken after Beginning Sailing are excellent, provide internationally recognized certificates awarded after passing a written and performance based exam, and include more advanced training. All information learned in Beginning Sailing is utilized in ASA Courses. See "Certified Sailing" on the caverunsailing.org website for more information if interested in these more advanced courses.

The Beginning Sailing Course consists of two evenings of casual class work in Lexington and one Saturday on the water at Cave Run Lake where you will sail with experienced volunteer captains in their own sailboats. If you have a sailboat, CRSA will provide a captain who can teach you on your boat if you wish. The water experience allows students to put into practice the principles they learned in the classroom.

Topics covered include:

types of sailboats, sails and what they do, sailing upwind and downwind, coast guard requirements, rules of the road, storing/folding sails, trailering a sailboat, boat parts and rigging, sailing terminology, safe sailing procedures, adjusting sails, leaving the dock, sailing etiquette, backing up a trailer, knots you will use, steering (tacking/jibing), safe boarding sailboats, handling shifty winds, returning to the dock, enjoying sailing, staying safe on the water.

This course is offered <u>only once</u> during each sailing season usually in May.

Cost: You must pay the \$100/family membership fee for insurance purposes, and the \$35/person fee for the Beginning Sailing course prior to the first class. Space may be limited and is on a first paid, first served basis. Please register at least one week prior to the first class.

## 2020 Non-Event Bluegrass Charity Regatta was a fundraising success! \$3,650 with nary a sailboat in sight!

And their early learning center with 120 children was reopened last summer. Now they even offer an Online Hearing Screener! There are services (in person and on-line) through their Audiology Clinic and the Speech and Language Pathology Clinic. They also provide daycare services, Early Learning Center classes, and summer programs for children.

Since 1988 **CRSA** has partnered with the women of the **THETA NU chapter of the philanthropic sorority PSI IOTA XI** raise funds for HSC. During that time the Bluegrass Charity Regatta has generated donations of over \$100,000 to HSC.


