

CRYSA CAMP RULES

- 1. No student near water without lifejacket and supervision
- 2. Closed toed footwear to be always worn.
- 3. No running
- 4. No swimming.
- 5. No jumping off boats
- 6. Respect one another: no bullying, hitting, pushing, or roughhousing.
- 7. Use respectful language to all-no swearing, foul, or rude language.
- 8. No littering on water or land.
- 9. Stay with the class unless you have permission from the instructor to leave.
- 10. No destruction of club or private property.
- 11. No smoking, drugs, or alcohol.
- 12. Keep hands fingers and all body parts inside boat and off Gunwales or side of boats.
- 13. Check for overhead wires in boat storage and launching areas.
- 14. All club boats and equipment must be returned, and all students must help with loading and storage at class end.
- 15. Sailors must make every effort to avoid collisions and safely come back to shore at slow speed.
- 16. Long blast of whistle means come to shore immediately, 5 short blasts means danger-locate and render assistance if needed.

Discipline Policy:

- 1. First Strike: Student will be warned and noted.
- 2. Second Strike: Student will be warned as well as parent/guardian and both will be asked to meet with Program Director.
- 3. Third Strike: Student will be asked to set out rest of day. Parent/Guardian will be asked to meet again with Program Director.
- 4. Continued Abuse: Results in expulsion from the program, Parent/Guardian will be informed. No refund will be given.
